Introduction

A new country and province record (viz. Ahvanu, Damghan, Semnan Province, Iran) for the nectar-feeding beetle, *Nemognatha chrysomelina* (Fabricius, 1775) is presented here.

Nemognatha chrysomelina (Fabricius, 1775)(Fig. 1)

Distribution: Africa, Balkan, Egypt, Greece, Syria, Tajikistan, Turkey and Turkmenistan.

Material: 12 specimens, Iran, Semnan Province, Damghan, Ahvanu, 3.7.2012, D. Makhan.

Comments: During the afternoon, specimens of *Nemognatha chrysomelina* (Fabricius, 1775) were collected from the desert and from the flowers of *Echinops* sp. (Asteraceae). The specimens were collected by hand.
